



## INFRONT HERB 'SEED' PROJECT

The farmers have asked for help to buy seed: herbs; spices; new vegetables; and agroforestry species. They have set aside some land to set up trial plots. They have an extension plan in place.

SILC has raised over \$1000 for seed (from family and friends) and an order was placed with Yates, Indonesia in April for trial batches of herb seeds as follows:

Chives	Parsley Plain leaf
Coriander	Sage
Dill	Sweet Basil
Marjoram	Thyme
Mint	Oregano
Parsley Curled	Rosemary plant

The seeds were delivered to the farmers in May 2009 and we are now waiting for feedback on the trials, which may take some months.

Soil test were conducted in early 2009 with a full report available on this website.
